Find out how many cases the surgeon has done per year and what kind. You may also want to ask if the surgeon has been recognized or awarded any special honors for their work.

It is also important to meet with the surgeon for a consultation to develop a relationship. This will help ensure the surgeon is a good fit for your needs.

Is your surgeon knowledgeable about the latest technology, such as computerized imaging? A surgeon who is up-to-date with the latest technology as well as the newest procedures that are available should play a key part in your decision.

Lastly, find out if the surgeon offers patient testimonials as well as before and after photos. It is imperative that you can see a collection of patients that have received the procedure that you are interested in so that you can see the surgeon's work and read or hear patients' comments about the work done.

And remember, while the expense of plastic surgery may be a concern for you, it is important to not base your decision solely on cost and to consider all aspects of your care when making such an important decision.
